Moreover, in 2017 he was one of the teachers in charge of the course «Uvod u proučavanje talijanskog prava», organized by the University of Rijeka (Law Faculty). He is member of the Editorial Board of the scientific journal "Social and Legal Sciences", and of the Scientific Committee of the scientific journal "Law and Forensic Science". He is the author of more than 300 scientific publications, including 5 books. He organized, and gave speeches at, several international conferences.
