The discipline studies the conflicting aspects and the cultural interchange established by colonial and post-colonial interactions, historically defined by the relations between Europe, America and Africa. Through the study of linguistic and literary manifestations, the discipline recognizes the plural identities that occur in works from both sides of the Atlantic creating a mosaic made by discursive, theoretical and fictional propositions. The study of the relation between language and literature (especially about places that use Portuguese and Spanish languages and their national varieties) also allows to analyse the temporality and the territoriality, producing critical and plural dimensions on different social discourses. The course incorporates discussions from the Colégio Doutoral Tordesilhas on languages, societies and cultures.
