Legal infrastructure for nanotechnology – Universitat de Girona (Espanha), Universidade Autônoma de Lisboa e Universidade Católica de Lisboa

From September 14 to 22, 2019, professors Daniel Francisco Nagao Menezes and José Francisco Nagao Menezes, linked to the Mackenzie Presbyterian University Political and Economic Law Program, attended the Universitat de Girona (Spain), the Autonomous University of Lisbon and, in Inovisa - linked to the Institute of Agronomy of the University of Lisbon (Portugal).

At the Universitat de Girona and the Autonomous University of Lisbon, consistent activities were carried out in the development of the Research Project, as well as in the formalization of the academic agreement between the Universities, with emphasis on the Faculty of Law.

In addition, UAL offered an intermediation to approach the UPM of the INL - International Iberian Nanotechnology Laboratory, the main nanotechnology research center of the European Union, located in Braga (Portugal).

At Inovisa, the incubation methodology of technology-based companies and the start-up's business model and their “disincubation” were known. A broad operating partnership was offered in Brazil, with the interest of UPM in incubating agricultural technology-based companies.
