1st International Congress "Social Inclusion, Public Policies and governance for the reduction of inequalities" – December, 04 - 2019

An event was organized with the participation of 2 international researchers with the Graduate Program in Economic and Political Law at Mackenzie Presbiterian University.

Prof. Pilar Jimenez, from the University of Salamanca, presented the theme "Higher Education and Competitiveness", comparing higher education in Brazil and Salamanca.
