Institutional Plan of Internationalization/ Mackenzie Presbyterian University (MPU)

- To contribute for the implementation of strategies and policies of the Institutional Plan of Internationalization (PII) of Mackenzie Presbyterian University.
- To use the resources of the PrInt project to send researcher commissions to international research centers with the aim of negotiating cooperation agreements in relevant areas, amplifying the participation of our students and professors in international networks and develop collaborative research projects.
- To transfer knowledge gained abroad to the University and the Country.
- To provide a relevant international experience to a significant portion of students in the post-graduate programs involved with the project.
- To attract foreign researchers to post-graduate programs associated with the project.
- To crystallize and expand MPU's position as a reference institution in different knowledge areas.
- To increase the international visibility and experience of faculty members active in knowledge áreas of the Institutional Project of Internationalization.
- To foster the establishment of new international cooperation arrangements in research projects associated with the themes.
- To increase the international experience of post-graduate program professors involved in the themes.
- To attract young talent and other researchers living abroad to MPU post-graduate programs and under-graduate courses associated with the themes of the Institutional Project of Internationalization.
- To support and consolidate ongoing research into the themes of the Institutional Project of Internationalization.
- To attract Brazilian and foreign researchers living abroad to the post-graduate programs associated with the themes of the Institutional Project of Internationalization.
- To foster the establishment of new international collaborations in theme-related research projects still in their early stages.
- To Increase participation on calls for research projects funded by foreign agencies, preferably from those countries that encourage participation on collaborative networks and are on the CAPES lists of preferred countries. For that end, it is fundamental to expand our researchers network.
- To Increase participation of researchers from MPU programs on FAPESP calls for projects, as
 well as other public funding opportunities that involve mobility proposals for researchers to
 collaborate with foreign institutions or projects in partnership with HEI from other countries.
- To Finish the implementation of the Portal in English, in order to increase the international
 visibility of the MPU, with not only the PPGs (complete and available for international
 students), but also the institution's research projects and working areas, offering an
 opportunity for researchers as well as prospective international professors and students to
 get to know and interact with the MPU research community.



- To increase the number of curricular units in English.
- To expand the number of bilateral double degree agreements in which academic and scientific credits and activities undertaken by the student in their original HEI are recognized.
- To consolidate the adaptation of the infrastructure and bilingual service for the reception of foreigners by means of English courses for employees, professors and students.
