Syllabus:

Study on the historical evolution of conceptions and concepts about people with deficiencies, in light of the Brazilian Legislation and the International Classification of Functioning, Disability and Health - ICF and ICF-CY - Children and Youth and Public Policies. Analysis of multiple conditions that surround people with disabilities and / or development disorders, favoring the critique of some processes and mechanisms present in the social relations, from certain theoretical matrices of Pedagogy, Psychology and Sociology, in an interdisciplinary perspective. Critical analysis of the ideological vertex present in social institutions and cultural products, especially in the media, identifying social attitudes and actions that may be characterized as mechanisms of exclusion, segregation and social inclusion in the areas of education, health, work, sports, culture and recreation

- Conception of people with disabilities in the course of history
