
Main results:

The mission was successfully conducted from an important set of research activities, study meetings, discussion workshops, as well as lectures given by researcher Prof. Dr. Carlos Leite (PPGAU-UPM).

Following the joint research activities initiated in Brazil, prior to the mission, based on the themes of common research, on the one hand, within the framework of the Research Project Innovative Urban Instruments and Social Urbanism conducted by Prof. Dr. Carlos Leite: social urbanism and the evaluation of innovative experiences of Latin American cities folding to others in the Global South. On the other hand, from the ongoing research by Professor Jörg Schröder (IES-Hannover) and his colleagues, dealing treating inclusion with methodologies of social innovation in urbanism. The advanced research, entitled Transition Peripheries, will investigate specific territories in transformation in terms of urban governance and community productive restructuring in Brazilian cities, Latin America and Europe, and will count with researchers from these countries, coordinated by the professors mentioned. The research should have its results in the form of joint articles that should be submitted to qualified journals of stratum A, an international one and another national, and possibly a new bilingual international book.


