Course Overview <p>This course examines the role of law in the sustainable management of living and non-living marine resources, considering the international and domestic context in order to highlight the relations between public policies, science and law. It promotes a study of the sustainable strategies of the coastal zone management and the marine spatial planning and the adaptation of the law. It also seeks to analysis the role of law in institutional and normative regulation at the federal, state and municipal levels in matters related to research, exploitation and exploration of marine resources, especially considering the limits to economic power.</p>
Topics outline <p>The role of law in the marine resources sustainable management. Limits to economic power related to the research, exploitation, exploration and management of marine resources. International law and domestic law in the context of the marine resources sustainable management. Activities: sustainable fishing, oil exploration, mining, navigation, renewable energy. Environmental risks in the coastal zone. Pollution, preservation and conservation of marine resources. Marine protected areas and marine spatial planning. Interface between the coastal zone and the marine space and the challenges for marine resources sustainable management of. National and international legal instruments for marine resources sustainable management.</p>
